This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco, Inc. has decided that certain model year 2025 Jay Feather Air travel trailers fail to conform to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 567, "Certification."

Reason for this recall The Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) listed on the vehicle certification label is incorrect, which can allow the vehicle to be overloaded. An overloaded vehicle can increase the risk of a crash.

Recall Remedy Remove the incorrect certification label and attach the new correct certification label. The recall remedy is free of charge. The remedy will take approximately 15 minutes to complete. The correct certification label is enclosed.

What we need you to do Our records show the following unit as affected by this recall, and is part of the current inventory at your Dealership.

Federal law requires the Recall Remedy be completed on this unit **prior** to customer delivery.

Please confirm the unit serial number requires the Recall Remedy using Unit Management in Jayco Partners. The instructions for the Recall Remedy are available under the Case Recall number in attachments.
