IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL INFORMATION Safety Recall Campaign 0187: MY22-24 Softail Brake Line Contact with Fuel Tank

Dear Dealer:

Harley-Davidson has learned that the front brake lines on certain MY22 - 24 Softail model motorcycles (see chart below) built at York Vehicle Operations between 11/17/2021 and 08/07/2024 may contact the fuel tank due to unintended bending of the brake lines during assembly. Contact between the brake lines and the fuel tank could, over time, lead to a breach in a brake line and a loss of brake fluid. If brake fluid loss remains undetected, front braking may be compromised, increasing the risk of a crash. This concern does not affect the functioning of the rear brakes.

We have voluntarily declared that this condition constitutes a safety defect to allow us to formally recall (Campaign 0187) all affected motorcycles. The remedy is to first confirm that the motorcycles are covered by this recall. If covered, perform the recommended inspection and, if required, perform the recall update per Service Bulletin M1672 (the "Bulletin"). The bulletin outlines the repair and credit procedures for the recall update, and additional relevant information.

All affected motorcycles will require an inspection, but not all vehicles will require repairs. In the event that damage to the brake lines is found, recall kit (part number 91500121) will be used for Campaign 0187. Recall kits will begin shipping the week of October 28, 2024. In the unlikely event that damage to the fuel tank is noted, please contact Harley-Davidson as listed below to obtain repair guidance. Due to limited initial availability, recall kits will not be available for dealer order at the time of launch. However, recall kits will be sent in wave shipments globally beginning the week of October 28, 2024.

In the interest of our customers' safety, and as required by federal law, you may sell but **not deliver** any affected motorcycles until the recall remedy is complete. **Please refer to *H-Dnet / My Toolbox / Warranty Campaign Center*. Select "Safety Campaign Open VIN list," then select "0187" Campaigns to view the VIN list.**

In accordance with federal regulations administered by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and other appropriate market-specific government agencies, Harley-Davidson or authorized Harley-Davidson dealers will provide notice to all owners of record of affected products with direction to arrange for the recall service.
