In accordance with the initial notice, the reminder should have stated, "Your Honda dealer will inspect your vehicle. If the vehicle passes inspection, no further repair is necessary. If the vehicle fails the inspection, the dealer will replace the high-pressure fuel pump for FREE. If a replacement is necessary, Honda estimates the replacement may take up to approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes. However, your dealer can provide you with a better estimate of the overall time for this service visit, as it may be necessary to make your vehicle available for a longer period of time."

Should a customer request a replacement, please explain the error and remind them of the inspection portion of this repair which was outlined in the initial notification.
