Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2023-25M Multi-Model High-Pressure Fuel Pump

On October 14, 2024, American Honda notified NHTSA of a stop sale and safety recall for certain 2023-2024 Accord/Accord FHEV, 2025 Civic/Civic FHEV, and 2023-2025 CR-V FHEV vehicles. It is possible that the high-pressure fuel pump was manufactured improperly, which can cause the fuel pump to crack, leading to a fuel leak. A fuel leak in the presence of an ignition source may increase the risk of a fire, crash, or injury. Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.

PARTS, TOOLS, AND REPAIR

Parts are unavailable at launch. We are actively working to increase production outputs. More information concerning parts availability, tools, and the repair method will be shared as it becomes available.
