Subject: Safety Recall RVXX2409, Bendix ABS ECU

Revised VIN List on 12-3-2024

Description of Defect:

Vehicles equipped with Bendix EC 80 ABS and towing capability may get an ABS fault due to miscommunication with the trailer. This could impact the ABS/ESP/AEB performance which may result in improper responses from the ABS system. The system may respond incorrectly to the event which could increase the likelihood of a crash.

We are not aware of any instance of a Volvo truck experiencing a braking or stability system failure as a result of this issue. There have been no field reports, accidents or injuries relating to this issue.

The Bendix EC80 electronic control unit software will be updated.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain 2020-2025 Volvo VN, VNRE, VAH and VHD model vehicles manufactured from May 1, 2019 through October 18, 2024.

Vehicle Quantities:

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal October 28, 2024.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before December 13, 2024.
- Repair Instruction will be released once they are available.
