



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 97B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2025 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some 2025 MY Ram 1500 vehicles may have been built with damaged front wheel bearing encoder rings causing a loss of wheel speed signal (WSS) which may disable Electronic Stability Control (ESC). Failure of the ESC system when intervention is expected and/or relied upon can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.126 S5.1.2 ESC Functionality requires that the ESC system "Is operational during all phases of driving including acceleration, coasting, and deceleration (including braking) [...]." Suspect vehicles may experience the ESC system being disabled.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to inspect and, if necessary, replace the front wheel bearing hub assembly. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2024.
