**Reason for this Safety Recall**

Winnebago Motorhomes has decided that a defect related to motor vehicle safety exists on certain:

2020 - 2024 View / Navion

These motor homes were manufactured **March 2, 2019**, through **August 22, 2023**.

Impacted units will be identified with labor operation code **24911111**. This labor op is for identification purposes only and will be replaced when the recall is activated.

**Description**

Certain Winnebago vehicles equipped with certain Lippert (Metallarte) door assemblies were manufactured with inadequate adhesion of the window to the door assembly.

There is potential for the adhesive used to mount the window in the entrance door to fail over time, which can result in the window becoming loose and/or detaching completely from the door.

A window that becomes loose or detached while the vehicle is in transit could become a road hazard to other motorists and increase the risk of a crash.

**Service Action**

Winnebago will conduct a voluntary safety recall; however, the remedy is not currently available. Dealers will be notified through established communication methods once a remedy is available.

We sincerely apologize for this inconvenience and want to assure you we are working diligently to remedy this situation.

It is a violation of Federal Law for a dealer to sell or lease any new vehicles in dealer inventory covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired.
