

New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – B3B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2022 through 2024 Model Year (WL) Jeep_® Grand Cherokee and 2021 through 2024 (WL) Jeep_® Grand Cherokee L vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an improperly secured front seat Side Air Bag (SAB) squib connector. FMVSS 571.214 requires front seat SAB deployment during certain crashes. An improperly secured front seat SAB squib connector may prevent the airbag from deploying in those crashes. A front seat SAB that does not deploy when intended may increase the risk of occupant injury in certain types of crashes.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 214 - Side impact protection.

SERVICE ACTION

All vehicles in this recall have been remedied by properly securing the front seat SAB squib connector. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2024.
