Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2021-2023 TLX Fuel Tank Assembly

On December 19, 2024, Acura notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for 167 units of model year 2021-2023 TLX vehicles. During manufacturing, the fuel filler neck may have been improperly welded to the fuel tank. An improperly welded fuel filler neck may allow fuel to leak, increasing the risk of fire and/or injury in the presence of an ignition source. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

Replace the fuel tank assembly.

PARTS

Parts will be available at launch via the controlled ordering process.

TOOLS

There are no new special tools needed for this recall.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin 24-057, *Safety Recall: 2021-23 TLX Fuel Tank Replacement* posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of December 20, 2024. It includes parts, repair, and warranty claim information related to this recall.

CLIENT NOTIFICATION

Acura expects to begin client notification in early February 2025.
