



# IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

January 2024

This notice applies to your vehicles, **VINs noted in the attached.**

Dear BrightDrop Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2022 model year BrightDrop EV600 vehicles. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

## IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM recall N232433420.

**Why is your vehicle being recalled?**

The front-drive units in these vehicles may contain a manufacturing defect that can, if operated in heavy-duty cycle use conditions, lead to an attended under-hood fire. If an under-hood fire occurs, there is increased risk of injury.

**What will we do?**

These vehicles will be replaced per our existing agreement.
