Dear Kenworth Customer,

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that certain model Year 2009-2024 C500/T440/T470/T660/T680/T880/W900 chassis manufactured from 01/09/2008 through 10/26/2023 fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No.121 Air Brake Systems. These vehicles may have air tank reservoirs with less than twelve times the combined volume of all service brake chambers, which could reduce braking capacity in an emergency and increase the risk of a crash. An audible alarm and warning light in the dash will warn the operator if pressure in the air system is low.

Kenworth has initiated a recall to install an additional air tank to increase system volume. This repair should take approximately 4 Hours and will be performed at no charge to you. Please contact your Kenworth dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. The problem is... Air tank reservoir does not comply with FMVSS 121
