This notice is sent to you in accordance with the U.S. National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Vermeer has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2015 – 2022 Vermeer BC900XL Brush Chipper. According to our records, you currently own a Vermeer BC900XL Brush Chipper. The model and serial number are shown at the top center of this letter.

WHEEL LUG NUTS MAY LOOSEN, LOSS OF WHEEL POSSIBLE

Wheel bearing grease/repack procedure in the Maintenance Manual included incorrect lug nut torque specification. Incorrectly torqued lug nuts can become loose. Loose lug nuts can cause damage to the wheel rim and result in separation from the brush chipper.

DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY POSSIBLE

Death or serious injury is possible if wheel separates from the brush chipper while being towed on a public highway, resulting in a crash. Property or equipment damage may also occur.

IMMEDIATE MACHINE MODIFICATIONS REQUIRED

IK004561 has been created to provide the necessary parts and instructions to replace incorrect Maintenance and Service Manuals, inspect existing parts for damage, and replace damaged parts.

IK024561 will provide updated service manuals to current owners of a Service Manual.
