IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Transmission Control Unit Weld

Dear [Name],

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA US LLC has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain
[2023 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup, 2023 Model Year (DJ) Ram 2500 Pickup, 2023
Model Year (D2) Ram 3500 Pickup and 2023 Model Year (DD) Ram 3500 Cab Chassis]
vehicles.

RECALL DESCRIPTION

The Transmission Control Unit (TCU) on your vehicle ^[1] may have been built with an
insufficient weld between the cover and baseplate. An insufficient weld between the TCU cover
and baseplate could allow transmission fluid to leak onto critical electrical components resulting
in a loss of transmission control. A loss of transmission control may result in a loss of drive
power or park function, which can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

YOUR VEHICLE HAS ALREADY BEEN REMEDIED

According to our service records, the Transmission or Valve Body and Control Unit has
already been replaced on your vehicle. Therefore, your vehicle has been remedied.

60 days. If you have had previous repairs performed and/or already received reimbursement,
you may still need to have the recall repair performed.
