Dear Ember RV Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Ember Recreational Vehicles, Inc., (“Ember”) has decided that certain 2023 and 2024 Overland, Touring, and E-Series recreational vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No.567, “Certification”.

IMPORTANT

Your vehicle falls within the recall population.

Why is a recall being conducted?

The Cargo Carrying Capacity listed on the certification label is incorrect, which can allow the recreational vehicle to be overloaded. An overloaded trailer increases the risk of a crash.

What are we doing about the problem?

The remedy for this recall, new corrected labels, is included with this notification. Ember has notified dealerships of this recall and has provided them with remedy instructions to install these new labels if you are not comfortable installing them yourself. You may contact your selling or nearest Ember dealer to have the recall corrected. Ember completely covers your repair cost for the remedy; you will not receive any bill of sales for anything covered under the above recall number. The installation of the label will take approximately 15 minutes.

What should you do?

Corrected Label Installation:

1. The labels are located on the roadside of the unit, front of sidewall above the skirt metal, and on the interior frame of the entry door;
2. Wipe off the current labels with isopropyl alcohol;
3. Match the labels and carefully place the new labels directly on top of the old labels.

If you are not comfortable with installing these labels:

Please contact your dealer immediately and request a service appointment to schedule the free remedy. The vehicle Owner is responsible for arranging to have the work completed. Please state you have been notified by Ember of having a recall in process of your vehicle and provide the recall number for the dealership.

You may also visit www.emberrv.com for dealer locations. If your distance from an Ember dealer poses difficulty, please contact Ember at 844-732-4204 or by email at warranty@emberrv.com. Please include your 17-digit VIN in all correspondence.

What if you previously paid for repairs to your vehicle for this recall?

If you have already paid for a repair that is within the scope of this defect under recall, you still need to have this recall inspected and/or performed to ensure the correct parts and procedures were utilized.

Additionally, you may be eligible for reimbursement of the charges you paid for the repair. To request reimbursement, please submit your request in writing along with the repair receipt to: PO Box 970, Bristol, IN 46507 or email information to warranty@emberrv.com.

What if you no longer own the recreational vehicle?

You have received this letter because government regulations require that a notification be sent to the last known owner of record. Our records indicate that you are the current owner. If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten (10) days to comply with federal regulations.
