IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 24513 NHTSA RECALL NO. 24V-750

This notice applies to your vehicle identified on the enclosed card.

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2024 and 2025 IC Bus® CE series school buses built 08/01/2023 thru 09/03/2024 and 2024 and 2025 IC Bus® EV series school buses built 08/02/2023 thru 08/27/2024 with air disc brakes (feature codes 0004XCJ, 0004XCK, 0004XGM or 0004XGM).

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The mounting bolts that fasten the brake caliper to the caliper anchor plate may not have been tightened to their specified torque.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

If the caliper mounting bolts loosen and detach, reduced braking performance could occur resulting in longer stopping distances which could increase the risk of a crash.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve an inspection for loose or missing bolts, if any are found they will be replaced and/or re-torqued to the correct specifications. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately an hour to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com> or by calling 1-800-448-7825.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 08/01/2024 thru 11/30/2024. **Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer** and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
