NHTSA Recall No. 24V-835

Dear Polestar Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

The reason for Recall RP1039:

Polestar Performance AB has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2020 Polestar 1 vehicles.

Polestar investigations has identified that the bolted rod connecting the brake pedal to the hydraulic unit may have not been assembled correctly at the supplier. The final torque might not be according to manufacturing specification. As a result, a reduction in brake support functions can occur, increasing the risk of a crash.

What should you do now?

The remedy, which will be free-of-charge to you, will be to torque the brake pedal pushrod screw according to specification.

Please contact your Polestar Service Point to schedule an appointment for the repair to be completed which may take up to one (1) hour to complete. Please note due to service scheduling your Polestar Service Point may require your vehicle for a longer period.

If you no longer own the vehicle described in this letter, please help us to update our records by sending us the updated owner information. Please refer to our contact information in this letter.

If you had previously paid for this repair to be performed, prior to receiving this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
