This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

VanCraft LLC has decided that certain 2003-2006 VanCraft Sprinter Campervan vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 209, "Seat belt assemblies"

WHY DOES MY VEHICLE NEED REPAIRS?

The rear bench type-1 seat belts are not installed with the proper anchoring hardware, which can lead to severe injury or death, for occupants using the bench seat, in the event that your vehicle is involved in a crash, without prior warning.

WHAT WILL YOUR DEALER DO?

Your authorized dealer service center will install the required anchoring hardware free of charge. The repair should take approximately 3 hours to complete. However, due to scheduling, your dealer may require your vehicle for longer. Your dealer should be able to provide a more accurate repair estimate.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

For your protection, please read and adhere to the following safety warning and instructions:

Do not allow any occupants to use the bench seating system while the vehicle is in motion. The current bench seating configuration presents a risk of injury or death if occupied during travel. We urge you to follow this guideline strictly to ensure everyone's safety.
