IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Seat Thorax Airbag Connector

Dear [Name],

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA US LLC has decided that certain [2022 through 2024 Model Year (WL) Jeep® Grand Cherokee and 2021 through 2024 (WL) Jeep® Grand Cherokee L] vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 214 - Side impact protection.

WHY DOES MY VEHICLE NEED REPAIRS?

The front seat Side Air Bag (SAB) squib connector on your vehicle ^[1] may be improperly secured. FMVSS 571.214 requires front seat SAB deployment during certain crashes. An improperly secured front seat SAB squib connector may prevent the airbag from deploying in those crashes. **A front seat SAB that does not deploy when intended may increase the risk of occupant injury in a crash.**

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 214 - Side impact protection.

YOUR VEHICLE HAS ALREADY BEEN REMEDIED

According to our service records, the squib connector has already been secured on your vehicle. Therefore, your vehicle has been remedied.

This notification is provided for your records only. There is nothing more that you need to do.

WHAT IF I HAVE QUESTIONS REGARDING THIS RECALL?

If you have had previous repairs performed and/or already received reimbursement, you may still need to have the recall repair performed.
