Dear International® customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

International Motors, LLC. has decided that certain 2025 eMV™ series built 5/21/2024 thru 10/21/2024 fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 103 – Windshield defrosting and defogging system.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The suspect vehicles do not conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 103 Windshield defrosting and defogging systems, S4.1. Each vehicle shall have a windshield defrosting and defogging system.

eMV™ vehicles may have been built without a required circuit breaker installed, which may affect the heater operation. Specifically, vehicles built without this fuse may not have any cabin heat to aid in defrosting or defogging the windshield.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Vehicles operating without heat in the defrost or defogging system may have decreased outward visibility in certain driving conditions, which may increase the risk of a crash.

DEFECT REMEDY

The repair will involve installing 5A circuit breaker and an updated label on the lid of the fuse box. The repair will be performed free of charge and take less than an hour to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any Authorized repair center to have your vehicle repaired at no cost to you. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected this defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 5/1/2024 thru 1/31/25. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any INTERNATIONAL® dealer and your eligibility

will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations. If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED FURTHER ASSISTANCE
