SYMPTOM DESCRIPTION

The Anti-lock Brake System (ABS) module on about 2 of the above vehicles may have a loose ground securement. This may result in the loss of communication with the ABS module which can lead to a loss of Electronic Stability Control (ESC). A vehicle with a non-functioning ESC system may increase the risk of a crash in certain driving condition.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 126 S5.1.2 requires that Electronic Stability Control (ESC) "is operational during all phases of driving including acceleration, coasting, and deceleration (including braking)" Vehicles with a loose ground securement may not have ESC operational during all phases of driving.

REPAIR TO BE PERFORMED

All vehicles in this recall have been remedied. There is no action required.

OWNER NOTIFICATION / SERVICE SCHEDULING

Owner notification not required per NHTSA agreement since the vehicles are already remedied.
