SPARE TIRE INSPECTION

1. The spare tire is mounted under the unit towards the front middle.
2. File for inspection only if the spare tire is a 15" spare tire.
3. Proceed with the instructions if the spare tire is a 14" tire as shown by figure 1 instead of a 15" spare tire.

SPARE TIRE REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Hoist Mount

The spare tire will be mounted against the underside of the recreation vehicle (flush mount) using a cable hoist to give it stability in travel.



NOTE

If your spare tire is a flush mount application, it must make contact with the underside of the recreational vehicle to insure maximum road clearance and stability in travel.

1. The crank handle to raise and lower the tire will be located on the door side of the unit next to the spare tire along the frame. Insert the crank handle into the crank access port located next to the sticker. (Figure 2)
2. Turn the crank handle to raise/lower the tire. Visually inspect to insure proper 15" tire is being installed (Figure 3).
