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Installation Instructions: OCCC & Altered Labels

Step 1: Prepare & Install OCCC Label

Identify and confirm you have the correct OCCC label, which can be identified by the VIN# posted at the top of the panel of the label backing paper. Ensure the VIN# matches the VIN# of the customer's van you are inspecting. If there is a missing OCCC label, please follow these instructions to successfully carry out the recall:

Remove the sticker from the backer and affix to either the hinge pillar, door-latch post, or the door edge that meets the door-latch post, next to the driver's seating position, or if none of these locations is practicable, to the left side of the instrument panel. If that location is also not practicable, the label shall be affixed to the inward-facing surface of the door next to the driver's seating position. Please do not remove or cover any existing labels on the vehicle.

Step 2: Prepare & Install Altered Label

Identify and confirm you have the correct Altered label, which can be identified by the VIN# posted at the top of the panel of the label backing paper. Ensure the VIN# matches the VIN# of the customer's van you are inspecting. If there is a missing Altered label, please follow these instructions to successfully carry out the recall:

Remove the sticker from the backer and affix to either the hinge pillar, door-latch post, or the door edge that meets the door-latch post, next to the driver's seating position, or if none of these locations is practicable, to the left side of the instrument panel. If that location is also not practicable, the label shall be affixed to the inward-facing surface of the door next to the driver's seating position. Please do not remove or cover any existing labels on the vehicle.
