Safety Recall: 2021 Civic Type R Seat Weight Sensor (DTC U3000-49)**Supersedes version 3 to revise information at:**

BACKGROUND

Affected vehicles may be equipped with seat weight sensors that are not built to proper specifications. Improperly built sensors could lead to cracking and/or a short circuit of the sensor, resulting in the illumination of the SRS warning light and the passenger airbag indicator remaining OFF. In certain collisions, these seat weight sensors may cause improper deployment of the front passenger airbags, increasing the risk of injury.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Owners of affected vehicles will be sent a notification of this safety recall. Do an iN VIN status inquiry to verify eligibility. Some vehicles affected by this campaign may be in your new or used vehicle inventory.

Failure to repair a vehicle subject to a recall or campaign may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits from the customer or anyone else harmed as a result of such failure. To see if a vehicle in inventory is affected by this safety recall, do a VIN status inquiry before selling it.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Replace the seat weight sensors.

1. Remove the label from the new seat weight sensor box and affix it to the repair order.

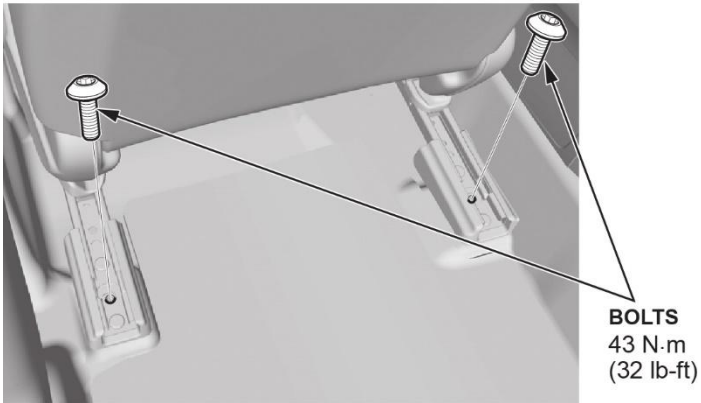
2. Remove the front side fasteners from the passenger's seat.



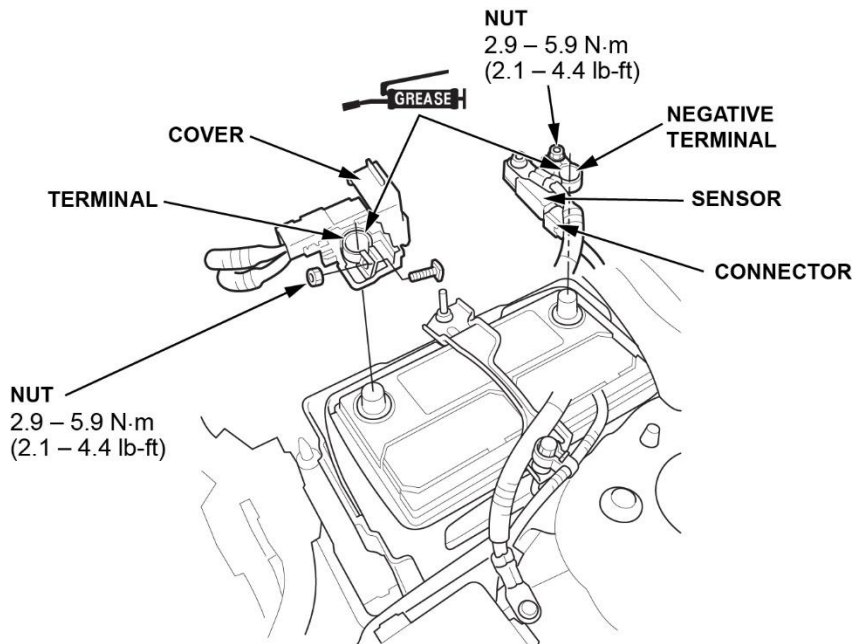

3. Slide the seat all the way forward, and remove the rear side fasteners.

REAR SIDE

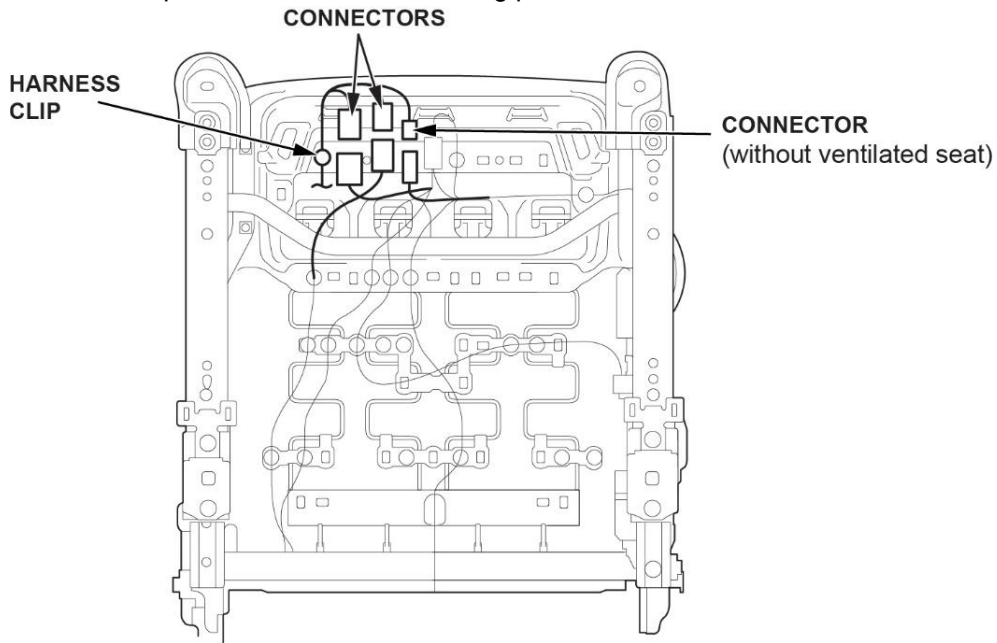


4. Disconnect the negative terminal of the 12-volt battery.

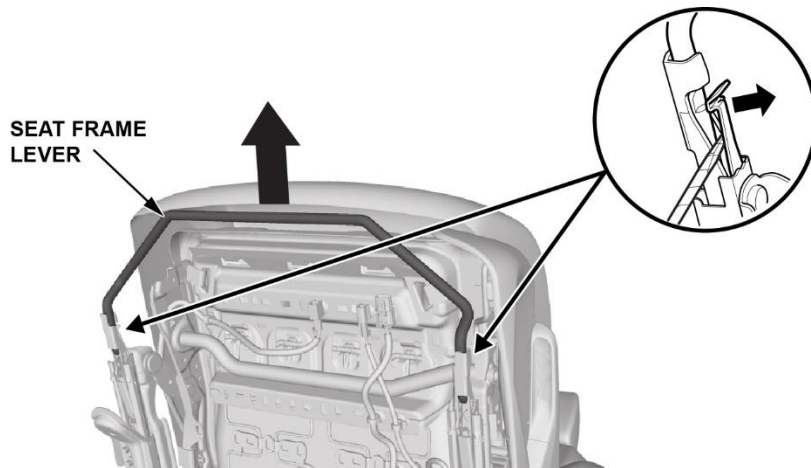


5. Lift the front seat, then disconnect the connectors, and detach the harness clips.

NOTE: Take a picture of the harness routing prior to removal for future reference.

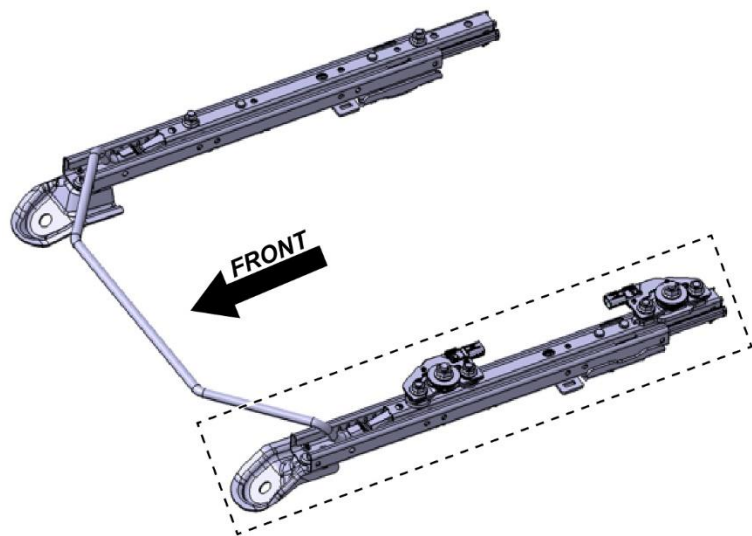


6. With the help of an assistant, carefully remove the front seat through the front door opening. Then, place the seat on a suitable area to work.
7. Remove the seat frame lever.

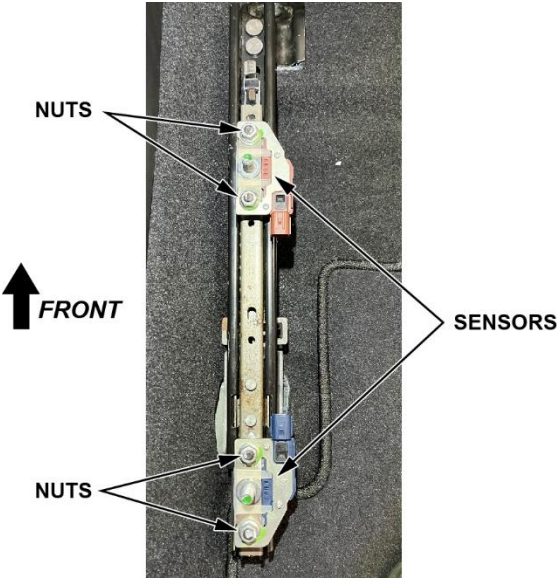


8. Disconnect the seat weight sensor connectors from the seat harness

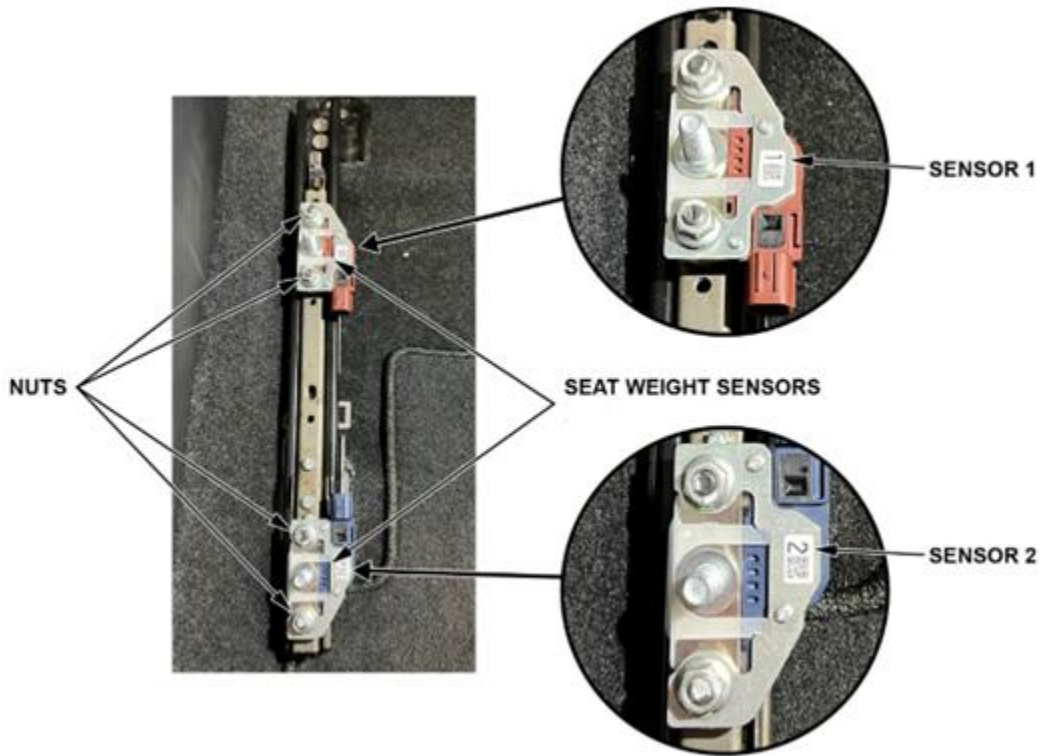
9. Remove the inner seat rail from the seat.



10. Mount the seat rail into the vehicle and remove and discard the seat weight sensors and nuts.

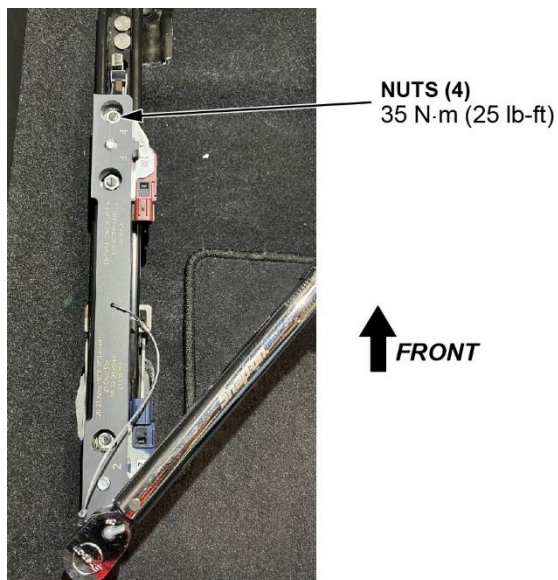
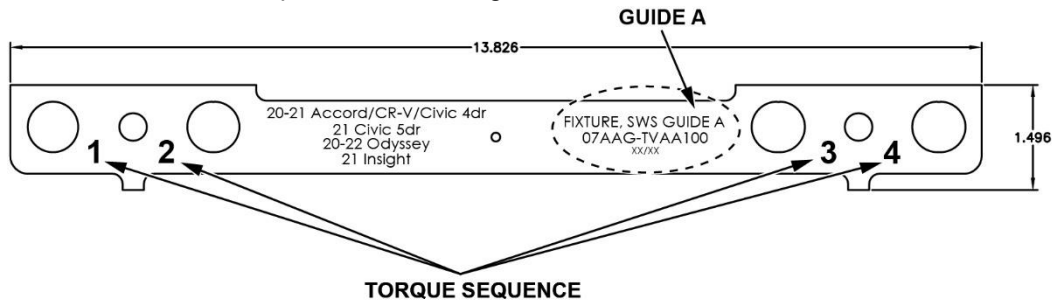


11. Loosely install the new sensors and new nuts in the orientation shown.



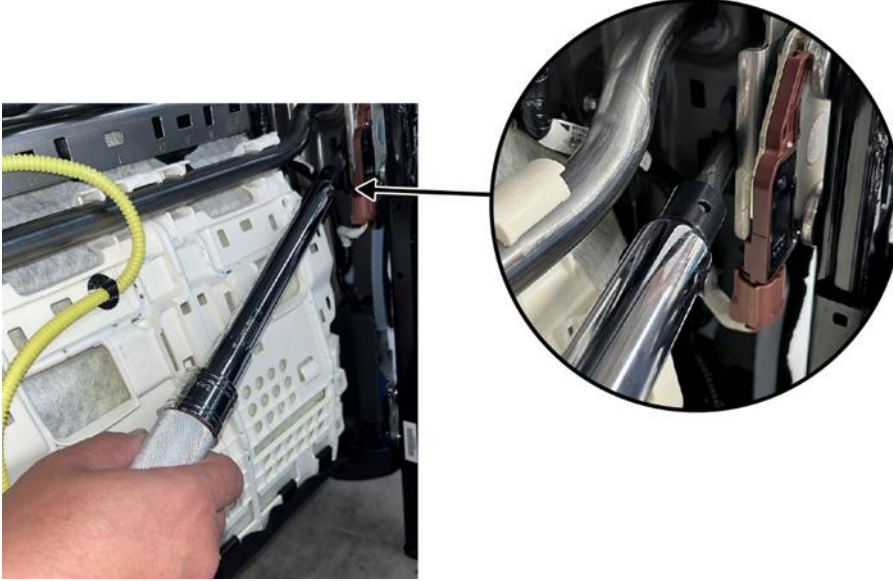
12. Place the SWS Fixture Guide A onto the new seat weight sensors with the tabs located to the inside of the seat track. With the guide properly seated on the new sensors, torque nuts to **35 N·m (26 lb-ft)** in the order shown on the **SWS Fixture Guide**.

NOTE: Use the socket provided with the guide.



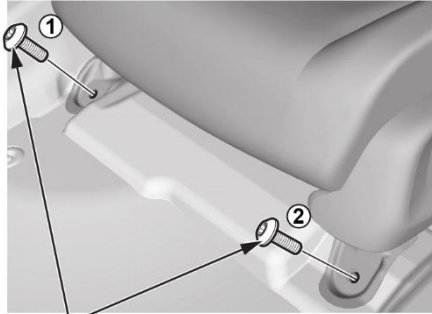
13. Remove the inner seat rail from the vehicle and mount it to the seat frame and torque to **55 N·m (41 lb-ft)**.

NOTE: Use the Snap-On Torque Wrench (07AAA-TVAA400) and box-end head to tighten the seat rail nuts. Install the seat back into the vehicle and connect the connectors.



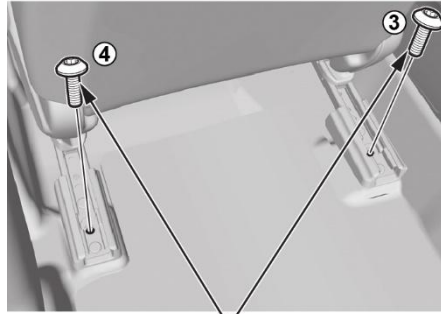
14. Install the bolts to the passenger's seat and tighten them by hand first, then tighten them to the specified torque in the sequence.

FRONT SIDE



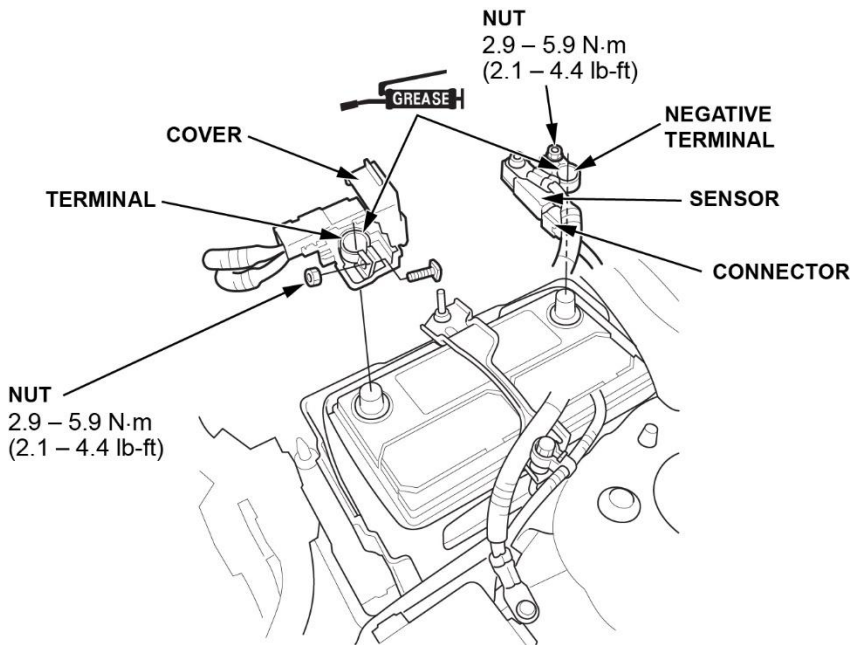

15. Connect the negative terminal of the 12-volt battery.

18. Confirm the SRS operation: Turn the vehicle to the ON mode, and check that the SRS indicator comes on for about 6 seconds and then goes off.
