IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Tire Certification Label

Dear [Name],

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA US LLC has decided that certain [2021 and 2023-2024 model year (GU) Alfa Romeo Stelvio] vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 110 - Tire selection and rims.

WHY DOES MY VEHICLE NEED REPAIRS?

Your vehicle ^[1] may have been built with a tire label and manufacturer label reporting incorrect nominal tire pressure values and/or incorrect tire size. **A driver may rely on the incorrect tire pressure and/or tire size designation, which can increase the risk of a crash.**

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 571.110S4.3(c) requires "Vehicle manufacturer's recommended cold tire inflation pressure for front, rear and spare tires" to be printed on the tire placard. Additionally, some vehicles may be non-compliant to FMVSS 571.110 S4.3(d) "Tire size designation, indicated by the headings "size" or "original tire size" or "original size," and "spare tire" or "spare," for the tires installed at the time of the first purchase for purposes other than resale". Subject vehicles are equipped with a tire placard label that does not correctly define the tire inflation pressure and/or the tire size designation. Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 571.110S4.3.3 "Additional Labeling Information for Vehicles Other Than Passenger Cars" requires "Each vehicle shall show the size designation and, if applicable, the type designation of rims (not necessarily those on the vehicle) appropriate for the tire appropriate for use on that vehicle, including the tire installed as original equipment on the vehicle by the vehicle manufacturer" to be printed on the manufacturer label. Subject vehicles are equipped with a manufacturer placard label that does not correctly define the tire inflation pressure and/or the tire size designation.

HOW DO I RESOLVE THIS IMPORTANT SAFETY ISSUE?

The remedy for this condition is not currently available. We are making every effort to finalize the remedy as quickly as possible, and will service your vehicle free of charge (parts and labor).

FCA US will contact you again, by mail, with a follow-up recall notice when the remedy is available. Once you receive your follow-up notice, simply contact your Alfa Romeo dealer right away to schedule a service appointment ^[2]. Additional options for your next steps are included on the left side of this notification. We appreciate your patience.

WHAT IF I ALREADY PAID TO HAVE THIS REPAIR COMPLETED?

If you have already experienced this specific condition and have paid to have it repaired, you may visit www.fcarecallreimbursement.com to submit your reimbursement request online ^[3]. Once we receive and verify the required documents, reimbursement will be sent to you within 60 days. If you have had previous repairs performed and/or already received reimbursement, you may still need to have the recall repair performed.
