High-Pressure Fuel Pump

This is an important Safety Recall.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Hyundai has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in **certain 2022 – 2023 model year Elantra and 2022 – 2023 model year Kona vehicles**. Hyundai is initiating Safety Recall 262 to address a condition involving the **High-Pressure Fuel Pump (“HPFP”)**. Our records indicate that your vehicle, with the VIN listed above, is affected by this recall.

The purpose of this letter is to explain what the recall is about and to keep you informed of Hyundai’s recall implementation plan. We are currently preparing to implement the safety recall remedy which, when available, will be performed at **NO CHARGE** to you. **We will send you another notification when the remedy is available.**

What is the problem?

The Fuel Control Valve (“FCV”) in the HPFP assemblies could allow excess fuel to enter the fuel pump. An air/fuel mixture that runs too “rich” might result in a reduction of drive power, increasing the risk of a crash.

What should you do in the interim?

We appreciate your patience. Hyundai is currently preparing to implement the recall remedy to update the Engine Control Module (“ECM”) and replace the high-pressure fuel pump, if necessary. You will receive a second notification letter when the remedy is available. In the interim, if you experience a reduction of drive power, or the malfunction indicator light (“MIL”) turns on, you should seek service at your Hyundai dealer as soon as possible. 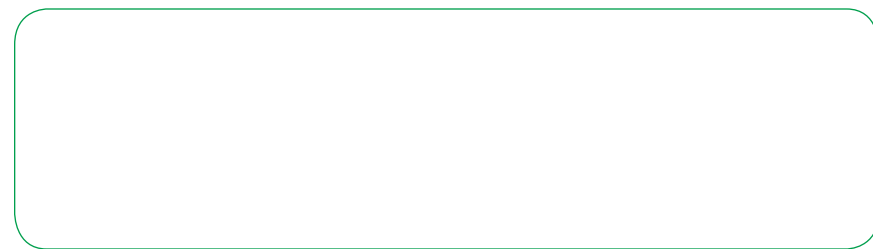
