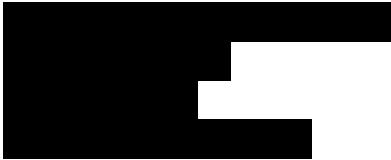




IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL – 24V-799

This notice applies to the vehicle identification number below.

November 1, 2024



Dear Valued Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Spartan Fire, LLC has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2024-2025 Metro Star and FC-94, and 2025 Gladiator and KME Panther model emergency response chassis cab vehicles.

Please note: The Vehicle Identification Number that may be affected by this recall is located at the top of this letter.

What is the defect?

On the affected vehicles, there is a potential for overextension of the cab tilt cylinder due to missing mechanical stop. Overextension can result in separation of the cylinder. This defect does not affect the vehicle while in motion.

Should the overextension of the cab tilt cylinder occur, the cab could drop at an accelerated speed, increasing the risk of personal injury. This could occur without warning.

Corrective Action:

Remedy parts are currently unavailable. In the interim, dealers will inspect the cab tilt cylinders to determine if the trucks are affected. There is no cost to the vehicle owner for this recall. The final remedy will be to replace the defective cylinder. Spartan will send a second notice once remedy parts become available.

Labor Time:

The inspection will take 30 minutes.



What You Should Do:

If you need further assistance with this notification, contact your local dealer to have the inspection performed. If you cannot locate a dealer, call Andy Haigh at 1-517-588-4162 to help locate your nearest dealer. Steps will be taken to ensure the recall inspection is performed at the nearest dealer.

Leased Vehicles:

The lessor must notify the lessee by first class mail within ten (10) days from receipt of their owner notification letter from the manufacturer; both for the initial notification and all subsequent notifications.

Reimbursement:

If you had this inspection performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy for the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact Spartan at 1-800-867-6478.
