This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

McLaren Automotive Inc (**McLaren**) has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2021 McLaren 765LT coupe motor vehicles.

WHAT IS THE ISSUE

Each McLaren 765LT coupe's tailgate window screen is made of polycarbonate and is attached to its support frame using adhesive. We refer to this as the 'polycarbonate panel' for the remainder of this letter.

The polycarbonate panel may be subjected to aero forces higher than the design tolerances in circumstances where the vehicle is driven at high speed with the windows open. There may have been non-compliance to the bonding process during production which increases the risk of a detachment occurring.

In the event of a full detachment, the polycarbonate panel could create a hazard for other road users, increasing the risk of a crash.

WHAT WILL MCLAREN DO?

McLaren will install bespoke fastenings into each corner of the polycarbonate panel as a mechanical retention free of charge.

The remedy is not yet available; we will contact you again when the replacement part is available. In the meantime, you can continue to operate your vehicle.

Until the remedy is available, we advise that you:

1. Do not drive the vehicle in excess of 96MPH (154KPH) with the window(s) open;
2. Do not drive the vehicle on a track.

If you are intending on driving your vehicle on a track before the remedy is available, please contact your McLaren retailer. A temporary measure is available on request for an additional adhesive compound to be applied to the panel, which would allow track use. It must be emphasized that this is a temporary measure only and is no substitute to the fastening remedy.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If you are not the owner of the vehicle affected by this recall because, for example, the vehicle:

1. has been sold or transferred;
2. is being leased and driven by another party; or
3. is primarily driven by a party not residing at the same address as you,

We sincerely regret any inconvenience and concern this recall and remedial action may cause you. However, your safety is our highest priority, and we kindly ask for your cooperation to facilitate the work required on your vehicle.
