Forest River has decided that a safety defect exists in certain 2023-2025 Dynamax Isata ISC24FWSFXM and ISC24FWSFXMCD Class C Recreational Vehicles. Forest River is recalling the defective model(s) to ensure the safety of our future retail consumers and your dealership. Forest River is issuing a Stop Sale Notice effective immediately.

If the nut is loose on the stud of the disconnect, the wires may arc and overheat. This condition may lead to a fire and property damage.
