Forest River has decided that a safety defect exists in certain 2024-2025 Cross Trail Class C Motorhome Recreational Vehicles. Forest River is recalling the defective model(s) to ensure the safety of our future retail consumers and your dealership. Forest River is issuing a Stop Sale Notice effective immediately.

#### WHAT IS THE DEFECT?

The Lippert Ladder Receiver mounted to the rear wall may have been inconsistently installed, missing the intended backer.

### EVALUATION OF THE RISK TO THE VEHICLE AND OPERATOR(S) RELATED TO THE RECALL.

If the ladder receiver detaches from the vehicle, an operator on the ladder may fall, which could lead to personal injury.

### **SERVICE PROCEDURE:**

The remedy for this recall is under development. A second notice will be sent when the remedy becomes available.
