Pursuant to USC49CFR §577.13 – Notification to Dealerships and Distributors – Paragraph B

“It is a violation of Federal Law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by the notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.”

Forest River has decided that a safety defect exists in certain 2024-2025 PUMA PUT39DBT Travel Trailer Recreational Vehicles. To ensure the safety of our future retail consumers and your dealership, Forest River is recalling the defective model and issuing a Stop Sale Notice effective immediately.

WHAT IS THE DEFECT?

The anti-siphon vent may have been installed backward "incorrectly". This may lead to reduced performance when filling and draining the holding tank(s).

EVALUATION OF RISK:

Sewer gas may enter the vehicle, which may lead to personal injury.

SERVICE PROCEDURE:

The remedy for this recall is being developed. Once it is available, a second notice will be issued.
