Pursuant to USC49CFR §577.13 – Notification to Dealerships and Distributors – Paragraph B

Forest River has decided that a safety defect exists in certain 2024-2025 Viking and Clipper Travel Trailer Recreational Vehicles. Forest River is recalling the defect model(s) to ensure the safety of our future retail consumers and your dealership. Forest River is issuing a Stop Sale Notice effective immediately.

Please access your Home Page on Dealer Connect to verify if your Dealership has units in stock that are subject to this recall. Enter the Service Campaign number referenced above in the “Campaign Search” field, click on the “Campaign ID Number”. Next, select “MY VINS”. Not all Dealers have units in stock that are affected by this recall.

The designated date range for this recall is 07/24/2023-10/31/2024

DEFECT:

The weld that attached the leg(s) of the bracket may break, if this condition occurs, the LP tank may become loose from the vehicle.

EVALUATION OF RISK:

If the LP tank becomes loose from the vehicle, this condition may lead to property damage, or a crash.

SERVICE PROCEDURE:

The remedy for this recall is currently under development. A second notice will be issued once the remedy is available.
