Affected tires were built with a nonconforming tread base rubber compound.

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

Affected tires could experience a partial or full tread detachment which may lead to an increased risk of a crash.

Description of the cause:

CTA determined that a nonconforming tread base rubber compound was used to produce four products during DOT weeks 4024 and 4124.

Identification of any warning that can occur:

Affected tires may exhibit localized tread wear, excessive vibration, noise and/or bulging in the tread area.

Chronology

Aug.29.2025: CTA received one complaint tire (CrossContact RX ContiSeal, 275/40R21 107H) with DOT week 4024 from GM with a partial tread detachment. Upon visual inspection, the detached area appeared to have an indication of insufficient adhesion. Because of this nontypical appearance, CTA initiated a more detailed tire analysis and alerted the production plant.

Sep.02.2025 - Sep.30.2025: CTA's investigation revealed that the tire was manufactured with an inadequate sulfur level in the tread base compound preventing proper adhesion. CTA endeavored to identify if other tires produced in and around DOT week 4024 were also affected.

Sep.16.2025: GM sent CTA a second tire (CrossContact RX ContiSeal, 275/40R21 107H) from the Canadian market that was manufactured during DOT week 4024 that had a partial tread detachment. This second tire also had a similar tread base appearance.

CTA determined that the nonconforming compound was used in DOT week 4024 for tires supplied to GM, as well as three additional products manufactured in DOT week 4024 and 4124.

Oct.01.2025: CTA's Management Committee reviewed the investigation results and made a decision to recall the affected tires.

To date, CTA has received two tires (one in USA, one in Canada) with partial tread detachments from DOT week 4024. CTA is not aware of any claims of property damage, personal injury, or death involving the affected tires.

Description of Remedy

Remedy Type: Replace

Consumer Advisories: Do Not Drive Park Outside

Description of remedy program:

Continental Tire the Americas, LLC (CTA) will conduct a safety recall campaign to replace all affected tires that have been sold either to General Motors (GM), sold in the replacement market, or remain in dealer inventories. All known customers, distributors, dealers and independent outlets who have purchased the affected tires will receive notification of the campaign. CTA is in close communication with GM to identify and notify vehicle owners that are affected.

The notification will include:

- Instructions for identifying the affected tires

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- Guidance on removing the affected tires from service
- Replacement option(s)
- Instructions for returning or disposing of the affected tires
- Details on the credit process

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

The remedy will consist of tires produced in non-affected DOT weeks.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

The recall condition was a one time effect which only affected four products of DOT week 4024 and 4124. Tires produced before 4024 and after 4124 are not affected.

Reimbursement Plan

Description of reimbursement program:

To be eligible for reimbursement, the following requirements must be met:

a.) completed CTA Reimbursement Request Form.

b.) A copy of the receipt showing the purchase of the recalled tire(s), including tire line name and size. Proof of vehicle ownership for GM vehicles when equipped with affected tires.

c.) A copy of the receipt showing the purchase of the new replacement tire(s), including tire line name, size and reason for replacement.

d.) Proof of payment of the new replacement tires.

CTA will review case by case and provide a response to the consumer.

Period of reimbursement:

Affected tires that have been replaced before receipt of the recall notification are eligible for reimbursement consideration.

A reimbursement request form must be submitted to CTA no later then June.30.2026

Costs to be reimbursed:

CTA will review reimbursement requests case by case and provide a response to the consumer. For approved reimbursements, CTA will reimburse the replacement retail price (including taxes) of the recall tire (s), plus up to \$30.00 per tire allowance for mounting and balancing service.
