## **Descriptive Information:**

Kia is conducting an FMVSS noncompliance recall to address a parking lamp issue involving certain 2025MY K5 vehicles produced at Kia Autoland Hwaseong from February 20, 2024 through April 23, 2025.

The recall population was determined by a review of Kia vehicle production records. The vehicles subject to this recall were not produced in VIN order. Customers seeking information about their specific vehicle will be referred to Kia's Consumer Assistance Center or their Kia dealer.

## **Defect / Noncompliance Description**

#### Description of the defect or noncompliance:

Due to incorrect software in the Power-net Domain Controller (PDC), when the turn signal is activated while headlamps are activated in a steady burning state or while parking lamps are activated, the corresponding parking lamp does not illuminate in a steady burning manner. As a result, the subject vehicles do not comply with the conspicuity requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 108, "Lamps, reflective devices, and associated equipment," thereby increasing the risk of a crash.

Front parking lamp will illuminate in a steady burning manner while the headlamps or parking lamps are activated.

Vehicles produced beginning 4/30/2025 are equipped with the improved PDC unit software. Vehicles produced from 04/24/2025 through 4/29/2025 will receive updated software prior to distribution to dealers.
