Descriptive Information:

Certain Wabash branded insulated truck bodies with an auxiliary battery box attached to the floor frame using bracket part number 08006516.

Defect / Noncompliance Description

Description of the defect or noncompliance:

Insulated truck bodies with an auxiliary battery box mounted directly to the floor frame have the possibility of the mounting bolts to be misaligned with the exterior floor crossmembers leading to inadequate strength to bear the load of the battery box and battery.

Description of the safety risk, including crash, fire, death, injury:

If the battery bolts were misaligned with the floor crossmember, the battery box could separate from the body floor frame while in transit, causing a crash.

Description of the cause:

Battery boxes misaligned during installation.

Identification of any warning that can occur:

A visible gap between the battery box bracket and the floor frame. Shaking or movement of the battery box.

Chronology

On 8/26/2025 a customer reported to WNC Warranty that a battery box had started to detach from the floor of a newly delivered refrigerated truck. An audit of similarly mounted battery boxes was conducted by the same customer and found that a total of three vehicles had shown signs of detachment.

On the same day, an incident was reported on WNC's concern reporting system to be investigated by the safety team. On 8/27 all vehicles in process were quarantined until a solution was developed. On 9/4 the single customer that purchased all vehicles part of this report approved removal of the auxiliary battery box as a solution. Quarantined vehicles would be shipped without an auxiliary battery box equipped. WNC planned on moving forward with this solution for the remaining vehicles in the field.

On Monday 10/6/2025 the WNC safety committee convened and determined that a safety related defect existed and would conduct a safety recall.
