IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL
NHTSA Recall No. 25T016

Goodyear Metro Miler G652 size B305/85R22.5 LRJ

Dear Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company has determined that certain Goodyear Metro Miler G652, size B305/85R22.5 LRJ tires manufactured in DOT date code week 4024 (10/6/2024 – 10/12/2024) and weeks 5024 to 5124 (12/15/2024 – 12/28/2024) (“Subject Tires”), contain a liner gauge condition that can affect vehicle safety. Goodyear is therefore conducting a voluntary recall to replace the subject tires free of charge, including mounting and balancing. We are contacting you because records indicate that you may have purchased one or more of the subject tires.

What is the Problem?

Certain Goodyear Metro Miler G652, size B305/85R22.5 LRJ, from weeks 4024, 5024 and 5124, may have been manufactured with a liner gauge condition that can affect vehicle safety. A tire with a liner gauge condition could result in air loss in service which could increase the risk of a crash.

What Tires are Affected?

This recall involves the following tires:

What Should You Do?

New Tires:

Records indicate that you may have purchased one or more of the subject tires. First, please check your inventory for any unsold subject tires. Any such tires found in inventory **must not be sold** and must be returned through the warranty return process described in the enclosed Goodyear Product Service Bulletin (PSB# 2025-10)

“YOU ARE PROHIBITED BY FEDERAL LAW FROM SELLING OR LEASING NEW OR USED TIRES COVERED BY THIS NOTIFICATION.” (including retreads and casings)

If a dealer knowingly sells or leases new or used recalled tires, that sale must be reported to the Associate Administrator for Enforcement, NHTSA, 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE, Washington, DC 20590, within five working days after a person to whom the sale or lease has been made has taken possession of that tire. The required contents for such report are provided in 49 C.F.R. § 573.10.

Second, we ask that you contact any consumers or other dealers who may have purchased one of these tires from you and ask for the tires to be returned for inspection and replacement. The enclosed Product Service Bulletin provides details about this program. We are also enclosing a Goodyear consumer letter that can be forwarded to your customers that purchased these tires.
