On February 5, 2025, American Honda notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for certain 2025 Pilot vehicles. During assembly, the passenger side third row seat belt may have been improperly routed, trapping and hiding the seat belt latch plate behind the rear side liner panel, rendering the seat belt unusable. If an occupant is unable to fasten their seat belt, the risk and/or severity of an injury are increased while the vehicle is in operation and/or in a crash. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

Inspect and, if necessary, properly route the passenger side third row seat belt latch plate.

PARTS

There are no parts needed for this recall.

TOOLS

There are no new special tools needed for this recall.
