Subject: Safety Recall RVXX2502 Air Brake Timing Non-compliance with FMVSS 121

Description of Defect:

Certain Volvo, New VN model vehicles do not meet minimum brake actuation timing requirements from FMVSS 121 (S5.5.5.1), which could cause a delay in brake activation and increase stopping distances. This could increase the risk of a crash causing injury and/or damage to property.

The remedy will be to install a new pneumatic circuit which makes the vehicle fully compliant with FMVSS121.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain 2023 thru 2025 New VN model vehicles manufactured from August 8, 2022, through November 1, 2024.

Vehicle Quantities:

8 (8 US)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal February 19, 2025.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before April 18, 2025.
