Dear Honda Dealer:

Honda is issuing a **STOP SALE NOTICE** on **CERTAIN 2024 and 2025 ADV160 scooters to inspect** the engine's oil pump driven gear for abnormal wear and noise . Due to a manufacturing defect, the gear may wear prematurely causing an inadequate oil supply to the engine. If the scooter continues to operate with low oil pressure, the engine can eventually seize, causing the rear wheel to lock up and decelerate while riding, potentially increasing the risk of a crash or injury.

Effective immediately, you **MUST NOT SELL** any affected NEW or USED 2024 or 2025 ADV160 scooter until it is repaired, according to the associated Service Bulletin. Additionally, you **MUST NOT SELL** or **INSTALL** any affected oil pump driven gear with part number 15133-K2S-N00.

AFFECTED UNITS

CERTAIN NEW or USED 2024 and 2025 ADV160 scooters:

- To search for applicable recalls on a specific unit, you **MUST** use *Unit Information* on **iN**, available March 28,2025.
- To manage your affected inventory, use your dealer *eResponsibility Report* on **iN**, available March 29, 2025.

ALL Oil Pump Driven Gears with a P/N 15133-K2S-N00 in dealer spare parts inventory.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin: ADV160 scooter #1, which includes all the information relating to this Safety Recall, is expected to be issued in April 2025.

PARTS INFORMATION

The parts needed for the repair can be ordered according to the instructions in the forthcoming Service Bulletin.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda intends to mail customer letters to all owners of affected 2024 and 2025 ADV160 scooters in May 2025. The letter will inform customers that their scooter may be affected by a safety-related defect and advise them to make an appointment with an authorized Honda dealer for repair.
