Please be advised that the remedy is now available for all vehicles affected by ASA3.

The TI is available in PCSS and the AfterSales Document Database here.

Vehicles requiring parts replacement are designated as repair Scopes 3 through 10. For vehicles requiring parts, we are currently at **Parts Status 2 - Parts must be ordered via PPL with a corresponding PRMS Parts Support ticket for release**. These vehicles will be checked for the correct scope before release. Your Porsche Center will need to order the reverse camera PAD980568C - QTY 1, as well as either 1, 2, or 3 of the front / surround view camera PAD980551. The TI clearly shows the number of surround view units needed based on vehicle repair scope.
