## Advance Notice – Compliance Recall 90A2 / Instrument Cluster ABS-Brake Telltale

**This notice is for:** All Dealer Personnel

**Date:** April 11, 2025

**Issue:** Government regulations require that either the common word "BRAKE" or other prescribed, specific icons are shown in text form for brake system malfunctions. It is possible that certain vehicles included in this recall do not have the correct data container to fulfill the regulatory requirement. Telltales that do not provide the prescribed warning according to regulations may cause driver confusion and, consequently lead to the driver ignoring the warning. If a brake warning is ignored and the vehicle continues to be driven, it can increase the risk of a crash.

- Repair:**
- REPAIR NOT YET AVAILABLE
  - Until the recall remedy becomes available, dealers should diagnose customer vehicle concerns and perform repairs, if needed, following existing repair procedures. This work cannot be billed/claimed against the recall.
  - Dealers and owners will be notified in writing once the remedy is available.
  - Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory.

**New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:** It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

**Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:** Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
