<b>Issue</b>	Mercedes-Benz AG, the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that the fuse boxes might have been incorrectly reworked on certain subject vehicles, during the previous recall remedy for 2024030008. As a result, a contact interruption or installation of fuses with incorrect amperage values for the designated location may occur. In this case, systems connected to the fuse(s) might become inoperable. The vehicle might also lose propulsion without warning, and restraint functions or the instrument cluster might be impaired, which could increase the risk of a crash or injuries. In addition, the risk of fire cannot be ruled out.		
<b>What We're Doing</b>	MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the fuse box and replace it, as necessary.		
<b>Remedy</b>	The remedy part(s) is not available at this time.		
<b>Pending Date</b>	Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as "PENDING" on Friday, April 25, 2025. The campaign will be visible on the www.NHTSA.gov website and may generate questions from customers.		
<b>Approximate Customer Notification Date</b>	Friday, May 16, 2025 Final customer letter can be found at MBUSA.com/recall or NHTSA.gov at the time of mailing.

- Loaner and demonstrator vehicles may continue to be driven, but must not be retailed until repaired.
- Once the remedy is available, vehicles will be flagged as "OPEN" and Work Instructions will be available.
- As a matter of normal service process, please check for other repair measures that might be applicable to the vehicle(s).
