This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco Inc. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2025 Entegra Coach Launch and Jayco Terrain Class B motorhomes.

***Reason for
this recall***

An incorrect standard outlet was installed in the kitchen instead of a GFCI protected outlet. A lack of proper circuit protection increases the risk of electric shock and injury.

***Recall
Remedy***

The remedy consists of replacement of the Non-GFCI breaker with a GFCI breaker at the load center. This repair will provide the proper circuit protection at the kitchen outlet. The repair is free of charge to the consumer and will take approximately 1/2 hour to complete.

do***
