## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 08C**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2019 through 2024 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup vehicles.

### **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an improperly secured Drivers Air Bag (DAB) squib connector(s). One or more improperly secured DAB squib connectors may prevent the DAB from deploying, or deploying properly, which can increase the risk of occupant injury in certain types of crashes.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.208 S4.1.5.3, requires that "[e]ach passenger car manufactured on or after September 1, 1997 shall comply with the requirement of S4.1.5.1(a)(1) by means of an [air bag] at the driver's and right front passenger's position." One or more improperly secured DAB squib connectors may prevent the DAB from deploying, or deploying properly, in certain types of crashes.

### **SERVICE ACTION**

All vehicles in this recall have been remedied by properly securing the drivers airbag squib connector. Warranty records show these repairs occurred between May 18, 2018, and December 27, 2024. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2025.
