RE: IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTIFICATION – **Recall 25V317**

To: Dealers

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

The Aluminum Trailer Company (ATC) has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2025 PLA550 Bumper Pull units with stabilizer jacks.

ATC has determined that the power wire from the battery to the jacks, if shorted out, could cause a fire. Safety of all past and present ATC trailers is our top priority.

Owners will be notified by mail about the recall. ATC will supply parts and instructions for installation to approved service centers for the repair at no cost to you. angle supports to be welded to the A-frame to strengthen the tongue on car haulers and tube supports on stackers and prints for installation. We estimate the time to perform the labor required to correct the defect to be .50 hours. There is no cost to owners for this recall. ATC will reimburse any customer providing sufficient documentation who incurred costs to repair the defect before our notification was sent.

Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal law for you to sell or lease the trailers covered by this notification until this recall has been performed on these trailers. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.
