Subject: Recall RVXX2505, Improper Power Cable Routing Clearance

Description of Defect:

Certain Volvo Heavy Duty vehicles may have been built with a specific arrangement of power cables where the 12-volt positive can encounter the 48-volt negative terminal and potentially cause chaffing and or then short. If the battery cables rub on the terminal, there is the risk of an electrical short that may disable power to the engine or create a risk of a fire.

If the battery cables rub on the terminal there is the risk of an electrical short which may disable power to the engine or create the risk of fire.

The power cables will be re-routed to ensure proper clearance and routing between the cables.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain 2025 thru 2026 legacy VN (VNL/VNR) model vehicles manufactured from March 4, 2024 through April 21, 2025.

Vehicle Quantities:

221 (221 US)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal on or before May 26, 2025.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before July 18, 2025.
