



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 44C

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2024 and 2025 model year (LB) Dodge Charger battery electric vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above battery electric vehicles may have been built with amplifiers with an incomplete software upload, which may prevent the emission of exterior sound. Vehicles that do not emit exterior sound will be more difficult for pedestrians and other drivers to detect, which could cause a crash without prior warning or increase the risk of injury to pedestrians.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.141 requires that electric vehicles emit a sound level and sound characteristics that meet the requirements of the S5.1 "2-band alert" and S5.4 "Relative volume change." Suspect vehicles may not emit the required sound.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to inspect and, if necessary, update the amplifier software. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2025.
