## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 49C**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2023 Model Year (WL) Jeep® Grand Cherokee and Grand Cherokee L vehicles.

### **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an HVAC blower motor that has a damaged connector, resulting in an electrical connection susceptible to failure.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.103 S4.1 which requires that subject vehicles "... shall have a windshield defrosting and defogging system." Suspect vehicles with a non-functioning HVAC blower motor may not meet the defined testing requirements.

### **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to repair the vehicle. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2025.
