Issue	Mercedes-Benz AG, the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain subject vehicles, the headlamps might be missing the required optical reference marking point on the lens. As a result, headlamp adjustment using the wall projection method by an independent workshop might not be performed according to the requirements specified in FMVSS 108. As a consequence, the headlamps might not be aimed correctly, which might lead to glare for oncoming traffic, which could increase the risk of a crash.		
What We're Doing	MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the headlamps on the affected vehicles and replace them, if necessary.		
Remedy	The remedy part is not available at this time.		
Launch Date	Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as "PENDING" on Friday, August 15, 2025. The campaign will be visible on the www.NHTSA.gov website and may generate questions from customers.		
Approximate Customer Notification Date	Tuesday, October 7, 2025 Final customer letter can be found at MBUSA.com/recall or NHTSA.gov at the time of mailing.		

Given this notice, it is a violation of federal law for a dealer to sell or lease any new vehicle in dealer inventory covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired. Violations of federal law may result in civil penalties.

- Loaner and demonstrator vehicles may continue to be driven, but must not be retailed until repaired.
- Once the remedy is available, vehicles will be flagged as "OPEN" and Work Instructions will be available.
- As a matter of normal service process, please check for other repair measures that might be applicable to the vehicle(s).

Additionally, given this notice, it is a violation of federal law for car rental companies to rent new vehicles covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired. Violations of federal law may result in civil penalties.
