Concern:

A concern has been identified on certain 2015 model year to 2017 model year Range Rover vehicles where the front suspension upper knuckle joint could develop a crack. In extreme cases where a crack in the front suspension knuckle has developed, this may lead to detachment of the upper suspension arm, which under extreme avoidance maneuver use conditions may compromise the vehicle's controllability and increase the risk of a crash.
