Subject: Recall RVXX2506, Dynamic Steering with Oversteer Guidance

Description of Defect:

Certain vehicles with dynamic steering and oversteer guidance, may experience an oversteer correction, where oversteer guidance may correct for an oversteer input and then continue to correct in the opposite direction. The resulting oscillations may result in a control issue which requires driver intervention.

In the event of a vehicle oversteer guidance intervention and without driver intervention the on-going correction could result in a crash.

The oversteer guidance feature will be turned off removing the safety risk.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

- Certain MY 2025-2026 New VN vehicles manufactured January 8, 2024 through July 22, 2025.

Vehicle Quantities:

- 2,720 (2,487 US and 233 Canada)

Dealer's Responsibility:

- The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.
- Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal on or before August 15, 2025.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before October 5, 2025.
